▶ The UK Register of Learning Providers

The **UK Register of Learning Providers (UKRLP)** is a 'one-stop' portal used by government departments, agencies, learners and employers to share key information about learning providers. The **UKRLP** allows providers to update their information in one place and share this across agencies such as the Learning and Skills Council (LSC), the National Learning Directory, the Higher Education Statistics Agency (HESA), the Higher Education Funding Council for England (HEFCE) and UCAS.

The **UKRLP** contains over 19,500 registered providers. Every provider has been independently verified against a recognised legal source or government register and has been allocated a UK Provider Reference Number (UKPRN). This is a unique identifier used to share information with the **UKRLP** partner agencies.

▶ Benefits of the UK Register of Learning Providers

Parents, school/college leavers or employers/employees looking for further education, university courses or other training can use the **UKRLP** to help them in their decision making. Information available includes course particulars, dates and contact details of learning providers.

For organisations, the **UKRLP** presents a wealth of information which can be accessed by all those within the sector, saving time by holding verified data in a secure central location. On registration, all learning providers are allocated a UK Provider Reference Number (UKPRN) Learning Providers are asked to ensure their details are kept up to date.

Common data definitions underpinning the LRS and UKRLP will improve the flow of information and can result in more effective and efficient data sharing.
